Ideal for hanging costumes, clothing, uniforms, large linens, backdrops, drapes, garments and more.



The Over Under Option is best for narrow aisles. This is the usual choice for a retrofit if aisle shelving needs to stay in place. Overnight you can double your storage space.



The T-bar Option requires more open floor space. This option is favored for long hang garments. These are also used at truck docks for staging and keeping fresh garments safe and out of the way.



The most ambitious option is the Quad. You get the most bang for your buck when you have the open space to work with. You will want access to both sides of the lift when it is down.
