

Garment Storage Made Easy

Why does overhead garment storage make sense?

1. Storing garments eats up a lot of floor space in your back room.
2. Every time they are moved they can get dropped, dirty or misplaced. Nobody wants to buy soiled or wrinkled clothing.
3. Climbing a ladder to get garments off of hooks makes mischief with dropped clothing and injuries.
4. When you cannot see or get to everything, inventory gets confusing and shrinkage can become a problem.
5. Every month you are paying for open empty air space that could be used for optimal storage. Your overhead space suddenly becomes very valuable.

How does overhead storage work?

1. The overhead lift mounts into your ceiling and there is no need for a remodel. You don't even have to move your existing shelving.
2. With a push of a button your garments come right to your finger tips.
3. Loading and unloading is easy because the hangers are at eye level. No more climbing ladders or injuries.
4. Push the button and up they go. Your garments are stored up and out of the way where no one can tamper with them. Your aisles stay open and clear.

Options available:

1. The Standard Model has a single hang bar which is the best choice for narrow aisles.
2. The Over Under Option gives you double the hang bar length for the same footprint.
3. The T-bar Option gives you double the hang bar length by putting the hang bars side by side. You will need more open floor space for this option.
4. The most ambitious option is the Quad Option. You get four hang bars per section and this is good if you have the floor space to work with.

- The overhead lift is a modular design. Each section is eight feet long so it is easy for you to optimize your space.
